As I mentioned in my email last week, the next Nimishillen Creek Core Committee meeting will be **Tuesday, September 12, from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.**, at the **Nimishillen Township Office located at 4915 North Nickelplate St. in the City of Louisville**. North Nickelplate Street is located east of Route 44 and north of East Main Street/Route 153. Since this is a **new meeting location**, I have attached a map, if needed.

The primary focus of the meeting will be to review the successful August 12<sup>th</sup> Nimishillen Creek LEAP clean-up held in Reifsnyder Park, and plan for our second LEAP to be held later this year in Nimishillen Township.
